money
Snacks will be available for purchase at camp. Snack Shack opens after lunch from approximately 1pm to 5pm. Please be responsible for your monies. Camp Counselor or the camp is responsible for any lost or stolen monies.

medical care
A nurse (medical director) will be present at camp. All medication must be turned into Pastor Paula on July 13th. Medication will be turned into and supervised by the camp nurse. The camp does not provide prescription medication. If your camper is presently under medication, please contact Pastor Paula upon arrival for check-in on July 13th. Include written instructions and place original prescription bottle in a ziploc bag labeled with the child's name. Permission is required to dispense over the counter medication, and will not be dispensed unless noted on the medical release portion of the child's registration form. In case of an accident or illness, parents will be notified.

transportation

Parents and/or Family Life will be responsible for transportation to and from camp. Campers should not arrive before 2pm on July 13th. Family Life will be providing a Bus for transportation to and from camp, returning on Monday, July 17th. Campers are discouraged from driving to camp. Those campers who do will be required to turn in their keys to the camp director until camp is completed or until they leave the camp grounds permanently.

camper supervision

Campers will be supervised by a Christian camp staff whose desire is to lead campers to Christ and to help them grow as Christians. A Christian atmosphere will be maintained at all times. All camp and cabin staff are required to complete the volunteer camp staff application every year. A background check is done on all camp and cabin staff.

closed camp policy

All nwmn kids camps are closed camps. No visitors will be allowed while camp is in session to ensure the safety and security of the campers.

swimming

A certified life guard(s) will always supervise swimming through the duration of camp. No two piece swimsuits will be allowed.

mail
